The council of the city of Cleveland hereby petitions your honorable body for the annexation to said city of the territory hereinafter described, and respectfully represents that two-thirds of the legal voters inhabiting the territory proposed to be so annexed have heretofore, to-wit, on the 18th day of September, 1911, the said council, by a vote of a majority of the members elected thereto, passed an ordinance authorizing such annexation, which ordinance reads as follows:

"Ordinance No.22439. An ordinance authorizing the annexation to the City of Cleveland of a certain portion of ShakerTownship. Be it ordined by the council of the City of Cleveland, state of Ohio, that SECTION 1. The following portion of Shaker Township adjoining

Situated in the Township of Newburg, now the township of Shaker county of Cuyahoga, state of Ohio, being part of original lots Mos. 418,419,420. 412 and 411 of said Newburg township, and further described as follows:

Section 2. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized to apply to the commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, to take such steps as may be necessary to cause the annexation of said territory to the city of Cleveland.

Section j. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication.

Ordinance No. 29905.

AN ORDINANCE to authorize the annexation of territory to the City of Cleveland.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Cleveland. State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory to said City of Cleveland be and the same is hereby authorized to be made:

Situated in the Village of Shaker Heights, being parts of Original Lots Numbers 420, 421, 412 and 413 of Newburg Township, and is further described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center line of North Woodland Road, which point is in a line parallel with and distant 265.0 feet easterly from the center line of Rice Avenue, now known as East Boulevard.

Thence from said place of beginning northerly, parallel with and distant 265.0 feet easterly from said center line of East Boulevard to the center line of East Boulevard to the center line of Fairmount Road,

Thence westerly along said center line of Fairmount Road.

Thence westerly along said northerly line of original Lot No. 412.

Thence westerly along said northerly line of of original Lot No. 412.

Thence westerly, along said northerly line of said center line of Fairmount Road to the intersection of said center line with the southerly line of Original Lot No. 412.

Thence morth 0 degrees, 23 minutes 40 seconds west along the westerly line of said original Lot No. 412, 530.18 feet to a stake which bears south 0 degrees, 23 minutes 40 seconds east, along said westerly line, 28.96 feet from the intersection of said westerly line with the northerly line of Ambler Parkway, said stake also marking the southwest corner of Cleveland Heights Village.
